# USS Firedrake AE-14 Reunion 2011 Information

For this reunion we are again offering a single price to include all of the following events. Lodging is not included and you need to make your hotel accommodations. If you are not able to attend for the whole reunion period call or e-mail Dick Tracy for pricing information to accommodate your special needs:

### EVENTS

Tues. May 10: Hotel check in at the Belle of Baton Rouge Hotel after 12 Noon. Evening Welcome Reception

Wed. May 11: Breakfast at the hotel. Take our bus trip to New Orleans to visit the National World War II Memorial. This visit will include a special buffet luncheon musical show featuring the Victory Belles. We will also enjoy the Solomon Victory Theater screening of Beyond All Boundaries, the Museum's signature cinematic experience. Then stretch your legs on your self guided tour of the National World War II Museum's exhibits that will encompass the June 6, 1944 invasion of Normandy, the Home Front during WWII and D-Day and the Invasions in the Pacific. Exhibit galleries incorporate text panels, artifacts, and Personal Account stations in which visitors may listen to the stories of WWII veterans and others who supported the war effort. Following our visit to the museum we will board our bus to go to our group Creole dinner at The Gumbo Shop in French Quarter restaurant. We will then take a brief riding tour of New Orleans to include Super Dome, historic St Charles Avenue, Garden District accessible by larger coach, Magazine Street lower 9<sup>th</sup> Ward and areas affected by Katrina, and parts of the Quarter accessible by the coach. We will then return to our hotel where you may choose from enjoying chatting with friends in our hospitality room, trying your luck in the adjacent casino or just retiring to your room to relax for the night.

**Thur. May 12:** Breakfast at the hotel. Take a bus trip to the LSU Rural Life Museum to see what life was like for most folks in Louisiana in days gone by. We will then take the bus for a short ride to Nottaway Plantation, in White Castle, Louisiana area. It is one of Louisiana's grand old plantation homes to see the opulent lifestyle of the plantation owners. There we will have lunch and a guided tour of Nottaway followed by time to tour the grounds and gift shop. On way back from Nottaway we will take a scenic route along The Great River Road to view other plantation homes and make a stop at historic Donaldsonville, the second capitol of Louisiana. We will have a 5 PM group dinner at Boutin's Restaurant, one of Baton Rouge's fine restaurants. Lastly we bus back to our hotel after dinner for evening on your own in our Hospitality room, the casino or wherever.

**Fri. May 13:** Breakfast at the hotel. No bus today! We will take a very short group walk to the USS Kidd Memorial at 9:30. We will be greeted and have a brief orientation in the lobby. Then the ladies will be escorted onto the ship after which the sailors will be rung on board. We will then hold our memorial service and traditional Two-Bell Ceremony remembering departed shipmates. After the ceremony you will tour the ship and the museum at your own pace. Following the ship tours it will be time for lunch on your own with friends. Many of us will likely walk to nearby *Shucks on the Levee* for lunch. Your afternoon is free for individual activities and socialization. You will be asked to return to the hotel for a 5:30 All Hands meeting to discuss where we want to hold our Reunion 2013. We will wrap up the day and our reunion with our dress up 2011 Firedrake banquet. As those of you who have attended prior reunions know, the banquet is a special event to close the Reunion and leave all of us with warm memories and firm resolves to convene again in 2013.

\*Note: a minimum of 50 reservations are required to maintain the above price. Bus Tour maximums may limit the number of participants or increase costs at some events so register early to be sure to get in on all events at this price.
